SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

In accordance with Governor Burgum's Executive Order 2020-19, Midway's 2020 election will be done through absentee ballot only. According to state law, the ballots must be available by 40 days before the election date. The election date is June 9 therefore the ballots must be available by April 30, 2020. An effort will be made to contact all patrons by mail with instructions for voting through absentee ballot. The information will also be sent through email and available on the Midway website when instructions are finalized.

The only item on Midway's 2020 election is the Johnstown region seat. Jared Peterka currently holds that seat and is the only candidate who has filed for the election. Even though this is for the Johnstown region, anybody who lives in the Midway district can vote.

If you are interested in an absentee ballot and do not hear any other information about it by early May, then please call the school and we will help you with the process.

FREE/REDUCED APPLICATIONS

Districts in North Dakota have been advised that we should notify our patrons about applying for the USDA Free/Reduced Lunch program. It's especially important to note that families that might not have qualified in the past could now qualify if a parent has lost his/her job due to the impact of closures from the coronavirus pandemic. If your employment status has changed to the point that you may now qualify for the program, then please contact the district office (701) 869-2432 for information about applying for the program. Any applications that are approved now will continue through the 2020-21 school year.

As a point of clarification, as long as the schools are closed through Executive Order, everybody in the district is on a free-lunch/breakfast program. The application discussed in this section would go into effect when school resumes and continue through the 2020-21 school year.

ESSA DASHBOARD

The state of North Dakota has submitted its plan for the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) to the US Department of Education. North Dakota was one of the first states to have its plan approved. Part of that plan called for the state to develop a "dashboard" that provides information about each school district. The first phase of that dashboard is now online.
