

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS & TERMS OF OFFICE

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: The Midway School Board (Board) will consist of five (5) elected members.

TERMS: The normal term of each board member will be for a period of three (3) years. Terms will be staggered so that only a part of the Board will be new.

ELIGIBILITY: Each Board member must be an eligible voter in the state of North Dakota and must be a resident in the Midway School District (District).

Each region of the District, as designated on the district map (see policy ABA), will be represented by one member who resides in that district. If a board member moves to a different region that person will stay in his/her position until the next regular Board election when a qualified person will be elected to finish that term

AT-LARGE MEMBERS

1. **REGULARLY SCHEDULED ELECTIONS:** If no eligible voter from a region has filed for a Board seat by the filing deadline, any resident of the district will be eligible to be elected as a write-in candidate for that seat.
2. **APPOINTEES:** In event of a vacancy and no person from that region will agree to serve on the Board, the Board will appoint a person from elsewhere in the District to serve until the next regularly scheduled election. The appointed member will be eligible to run for the remainder of that term at the next regularly scheduled election. After the term is completed, the seat is once again available only to an eligible voter from that region.
