

HONOR ROLL REGULATIONS

Honors Designation for Graduates

Honor students have demonstrated academic excellence throughout their high school career and have thus earned the right to receive this prestigious recognition. To be considered an Honor Student at Midway High School, a student must meet the following criteria:

1. Have an accumulated grade point average (grades 9-12) of 94% or above at the end of the third quarter of the senior year.
2. This grade point average will take into account all courses.
3. A student must have accumulated at least 10 of the credit as a Midway student to be eligible for this designation.

Quarterly Honor Roll

“A” and “B” honor rolls will be calculated every nine weeks.

To be on the “A” Honor Roll, a student must have maintained an average of 94% or better. The “B” honor roll will include students who have maintained an average of 87%-93%. Students having incompletes on their report cards at the time of the Honor Roll preparation will not be eligible for the Honor Roll
