

STUDENT PRAYER DURING NON-INSTRUCTIONAL TIME

Students are permitted to engage in religious expression during non-instructional time, i.e., before school, after school, during lunch and recess, and while not engaged in school activities. Religious expressions permitted include, but are not limited to, Bible reading, prayer, scripture reading, and grace before meals. These activities may be engaged in by individual students. However, the exercise of constitutional rights of religious expression may not be engaged in when the expression disrupts educational activities or extracurricular activities.

The decision to participate or not participate in religious expression is a matter of individual choice. No student will be permitted to harass or intimidate other students to participate or refrain from participating in religious expression.
