

## SUMMER SCHOOL

The Midway School District may conduct a summer school program each year. Its purpose will be to provide additional opportunities for students to receive remedial instruction and participate in enrichment activities. Summer school attendance does not in any way guarantee promotion for students. The length of the summer school session will be determined by the Midway School Board (Board) in accordance with elementary or secondary needs.

Preregistration shall precede the issuance of summer teacher contracts, and only that number of staff required for the operation of the program shall be employed.

Special experimental or pilot programs may be developed and presented when approved by the Board.

Courses may be provided which are:

1. An extension of the regular program and provides additional opportunities for students who have not progressed at the desired rate.
2. Enriching in nature and provide opportunities for students to develop special talents or pursue special interests not available to them during the regular year.
3. Designated to provide students with opportunities to improve their understanding of course materials and concepts not sufficiently mastered during the regular school year.

Summer school may not be used to achieve early graduation. Summer school courses may be used to complete courses that were begun or failed in regular session in order to allow the proper succession of courses to achieve graduation from high school in the normal four years.
