

COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

It is the desire of the Midway School Board (Board) to contribute to the welfare of the community by making tax-supported facilities available to non-student groups for educational, recreational, and civic and cultural activities to the fullest extent possible so long as these activities do not interfere with the regular school program and are conducted in accordance with the Board's rules and regulations and at no cost to the Midway School District. Charges may be made for the use of facilities to cover the cost of heat, lights, custodial service, and other incidentals.

Equal rights and privileges shall be accorded to all religious denominations and to all political parties.

The Superintendent shall establish regulations for the community use of school facilities which shall include responsibility for supervision and a procedure for assuring that appropriate insurance coverages are in place prior to outside use of school facilities.

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
