MIDWAY FOOD PANTRY

The Food Pantry at Midway has been very active since the Pandemic. We have been serving up to 18 families each week. There has been a wonderful response for funds to support the Pantry. Several thousand dollars has come in from the Midway community as well as some from outside of our school district. We just want to take this opportunity to thank those who have donated funds or food items directly to the Pantry. We can't thank you enough. Without this support we would not have been able to do what we do, as the monthly food supply chain coming from Fargo's Great Plains Food Bank has been reduced due to recent demand.

Due to demand, shopping restocking of the Pantry has been done weekly. Food has been distributed on Wednesdays to families with school-aged students who request such. It is expected that we will continue to provide this service through Wednesday, June 24th. After that date, there will be no more Food Pantry deliveries made by the school directly to homes.

However, if there are still families or individuals who continue to have a need over the Summer, a call can be made to the school to arrange a time for pick-up of a food bag at Midway. Of course we will be following all suggested social distancing and safety requirements that remain in effect during these times. (Most likely the bags will be given out at the front doors of the school).

We are fortunate to have this service at Midway. Please do not hesitate to utilize it if you have a need. We are well stocked. You do not have to have a student attending Midway to get food, but we do prefer to serve only those living within the Midway School District.
